This is a MAJOR GRADE for the students. Dress for them is concert black. (black shirt, pants, and shoes) Ties are optional but suggested.

➤ The **Lexington VETERAN'S DAY PARADE** has been moved to Monday, November 11<sup>th</sup>. We have had it on our calendar as the 9<sup>th</sup> since it was on Saturday this past year. Given the lengthy advance notice of the change, Marching Band members are still expected to participate in the event.

Having less than that creates unnecessary wear and tear on the equipment as the few we have are scrambling to get it all where it is supposed to be. Also, we could possibly have someone get injured in the rush to make all this happen in the limited performance window we usually have.
