 - c. We will hold the following fundraisers this year – fruit sale, Dewey's store (our biggest fundraiser), butter braid/cookie dough in the spring and at least one more.
 - d. Introduced the BAND App and how we will be using it this year.
- C. Tonya Tanner-Cecil - Treasurer
 - a. Be sure to get a membership form to fill out and turn in if you haven't already so we can have your contact information.
 - b. There is a band fee form in each student's binder.
 - i. Note what items your student needs for this year.
 - ii. If you pay your band fee before the end of Band Camp (August 5th) you get a discount and only need to pay \$200; after that it will be \$250.
 - iii. If you play a school owned instrument you will also have a \$50 fee. This helps cover upkeep and repairs.
