- a. Fruit Sale We had \$12,080 in in-person sales for a \$3310 profit, \$3850 in online sales that will be delivered to the school for a \$1051 profit and \$1260 in online sales that will be sent to the individual for a \$341.50 profit. Total sales were \$17,190 for a total profit of \$4702. This amount does not include any donations that were made.
- b. Dewey's Store Jon Hamby Going well. We were able to open a week earlier than in the past. Have been told by Dewey's that we will not run out of product. We will not get Devonshire or Grandpa cakes until two weeks from now. In two weeks, we will also have a stock of generic Oak Grove items to sell. We have a TV in the window rotating the Oak Grove logo, product pictures, etc. that will run 24 hours per day. Big banner will go up this weekend. Volunteers, volunteers, volunteers needed.
- B. Transportation Joe Rose & Phil McManus
 - a. Joe Would like to get an actual receiver to allow a greater variety of vehicles to tow the trailer. We had one at one time but it was ruined. Cost would be between \$300 \$500.
 - b. Phil We have new vinyl decals for the trailer in black with white lettering including Amigos. They were picked up before COVID hit so we will put on for next season.
