

Meeting was called to order at 7:06 pm.

FINANCIAL REPORT – Tonya Tanner-Cecil

We currently have a balance of \$33,425.06 in the account. Still have outstanding band fees in the amount of \$4150. Fundraising amounts this year - \$9269 from cookie dough/cheesecake fundraiser, \$8800 from Dewey's so far (waiting for final check from them), \$5505 from the fruit sale, \$738.75 from Kona Ice, \$475.15 from Pampered Chef and \$2398 from concessions.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

- A. Fundraising – Brooke Hamby
  - a. Butter Braids – Will run sale from right before spring break to a week and a half after spring break. Delivery will be in May. Working on getting letter for students typed up.

STAFF REPORT:

- A. Mr. Howell – 44 high school students made All County. Looking at the first two weeks of August for Band Camp. Will get contracts for marching band out as soon as date is set. First home football game not until September 9<sup>th</sup>. Doing a last-ditch effort to collect outstanding band fees starting tomorrow.
- B. Mr. Liner – 27 students made All County. Got a bari sax. Is waiting on bids for the storage cabinets needed. Has assembled the music library.

OLD BUSINESS:

- A. Storage Building – Have to have the blueprints for the building and all plans in a packet to present to Mr. Dalton for approval before moving forward. Concrete for pas will be \$80 per yard using discount from Phil's company (normally it's \$140 per yard). Phil can get us a definite quote once we know details of the building.
- B. Trailer – Northern Tool has a 4x8 for \$819 or 5x8 for \$950. Would also need plywood for base which would be \$75 per sheet. Joe is waiting on a call from three other trailer companies and Brooke is waiting to hear from one other. Mr. Liner will reach out to some people he knows about building trailers that would be specific to our needs as a band and creating a "train" of trailers.

NEW BUSINESS:

- A. Band Banquet – Hope City Church was not available. The other possibility would be the OGHS stadium – it would be free, no set limit on number of people we could have, could set up tables in the area above the bleachers. Set date for May 21<sup>st</sup> at 7:00 pm. Students will be free (invite all middle school, high school and marching band students); rest of their families will pay. Catering – can get four pans of spaghetti, salad and bread for \$400 then \$75 for each additional pan. Put tickets on sale the week after spring break.
